Frequently Asked Questions

Are children welcome at Tea Trails? Children of any age are welcome at Tea Trails. Two children up to the age of 12 years can share their parents' room. An additional bed will be provided. Bearing in mind the peace and quiet that most guests prefer, we ask that parents ensure that children are not noisy inside the bungalow. Kids will have plenty of opportunities to scream and shout on the various excursions that we offer...

What is the weather like? As Tea Trails is at an elevation of 4000 feet, the climate is cooler and less humid than in Colombo and on the coast. Typically cool mornings, warm days and cool evenings. Daytime temperatures are comfortable in the low 20's C and at night can drop to 10 C hence the fireplaces in all bungalows.

Which is the best season to visit? Tea Trails is a year round destination. The driest part of the year is between December and April. June/July and October/November are wetter months due to the monsoon. However the ambience of the bungalows is such that you'd think there's nothing better than curling up in front of a fire with a good book.

What should we wear?

There is no particular dress code. Bring a light sweater for cool mornings and evenings, sturdy walking shoes to explore and in the monsoon months, a waterproof top.

What kind of terrain is available for hiking? This region offers a great variety of hikes. You can choose from a leisurely promenade to a real hike of up to 6 hours. We offer maps and guides. We have marked recommended routes from each bungalow.

Why are all meals & drinks included? We want you to feel at home, without being presented with bills. And due to our isolated location, there are no other restaurants and bars. Our prices are therefore inclusive of Bed tea, cooked English or Sri Lankan breakfast, lunch (packed lunch if on excursion), afternoon cream tea, pre-dinner cocktails, 4 course gourmet dinner, house wines, International spirits, beer, soft drinks, tea & coffee, laundry, calls within Sri Lanka and other bungalow amenities.

What kind of transport arrangements are available from the airport / Colombo? Most guests come by private car either as part of a bigger exploration around Sri Lanka or arranged by Ceylon Tea Trails. The journey time is 4 hours from Colombo, 2 hours from Kandy or 1.45 hours from Nuwara Eliya.

Do you have accommodation for drivers? We have secured accommodation for drivers in the area, 6-8km away from the bungalows.
