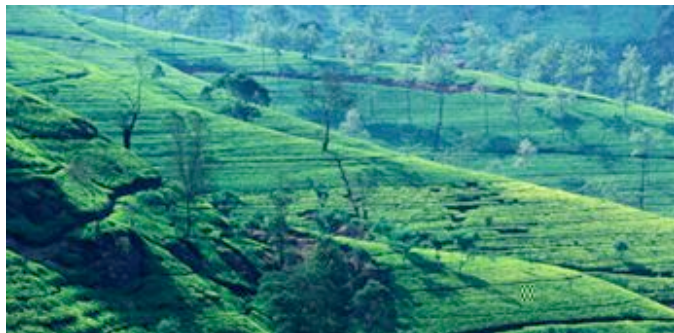

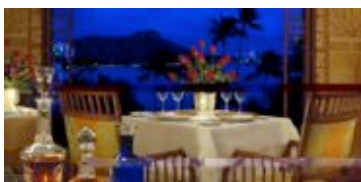

HONOLULU, HAWAII

LONDON, ENGLAND
